	<u>HB 374</u>	LESSOR/LESSEE: Provides relative to residential lessee screening	Signed by Governor – <b>Act 422</b>
	<u>SB 215</u>	EMPLOYMENT: Provides for the reasonable accommodations of employees who become temporarily disabled due to certain medical conditions.	Signed by Governor – <b>Act 393</b>
<b>Diversify/increase perinatal workforce</b>	<u>HB 495</u>	NURSES: Allows full practice authority for advanced practice registered nurses. Removal of CPA.	Died in session
	<u>HB 190</u>	INSURANCE/HEALTH: Provides relative to maternity services of midwives and doulas.	Signed by Governor – <b>Act 182</b>
<b>Promote extended Medicaid to one year postpartum</b>	<u>HB 468</u>	MEDICAID: Provides relative to the extension of Medicaid coverage for an individual experiencing postpartum.	Died in session
	<u>HR 193</u>	MEDICAID: Requests La. Dept. of Health to amend the Medicaid state plan to allow for postpartum Medicaid coverage for 12 months after childbirth for certain pregnant individuals	Sent to Secretary of State
<b>Improve maternal healthcare/support for incarcerated birthing people</b>	<u>HCR 85</u>	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS: Requests a study of policies relative to certain health issues of women prisoners	Sent to Secretary of State
<b>Invest in maternal mental health care and substance use disorder treatment</b>	<u>HB 146</u>	TAX CREDITS: Establishes an income tax credit following the delivery of a stillborn child	Signed by Governor – <b>Act 467</b>
	<u>HCR 103</u>	MENTAL HEALTH: Requests that certain state agencies address the impacts of maternal depression and anxiety and provide evidence-based preventive care, early identification, and treatment services	Sent to Secretary of State
	<u>HCR 105</u>	MENTAL HEALTH: Establishes the Louisiana Maternal Mental Health Task Force for the purposes of advancing education and treatment and improving services relating to maternal mental health	Sent to Secretary of State
